Narrative summary			
E-Crash; Log Only: Reportedly Unit 1/1A, a tractor trailer combination occupied by one, was driving westbound in the righthand lane of travel on Interstate 84 near milepost 221. The driver stated that a herd of elk ran across the roadway from the righthand shoulder towards the westbound side of the roadway and caused him to lock up his brakes to avoid a collision with the elk and other nearby CMV's. The elk were still visible in the ravine below upon OSP arrival. Unit 1 left the roadway on the righthand shoulder and came to an uncontrolled rest in a jack-knifed position. Unit 1 damaged a single mile marker post as it left the roadway. There were no injuries and RWC Group Towing responded to assist in removal. No enforcement action was taken against the driver.
